Year end Report Cards

District Owned Chromebooks that some families have borrowed don't return.

At present the chromebooks that families received Division lent Chromebooks are not needed to be returned to the school. These chromebooks are considered end of life so they are not needed at the school next year. More information will be shared in the fall in regards to chromebooks. In the meantime continue to use the chromebook to access educational games over the summer.
